CIMA Patagonia is made up of around one hundred companies engaged in industry and the production of industrial goods and services linked to the region's main productive activities. Its members are located in various cities and towns across Patagonia, including Puerto Madryn, Trelew, Rawson, Comodoro Rivadavia, Esquel, Caleta Olivia,

Río Gallegos, Gobernador Gregores, Perito Moreno, among others.

CIMA Patagonia's headquarters are located within the premises of the Puerto Madryn Technology Park, housed in its own 463 m² building. The facility includes a multipurpose auditorium with a flexible layout adaptable to a wide range of

needs—meetings, training sessions, and presentations—complemented by a laboratory and office spaces. In recent months, new technology has been incorporated, and the auditorium is now equipped with a state-of-the-art videoconferencing system ■

In 2018, it incubated the Arbacia Project, focused on developing products for the pharmaceutical, nutraceutical, and cosmetic industries through the cultivation of sea urchins.

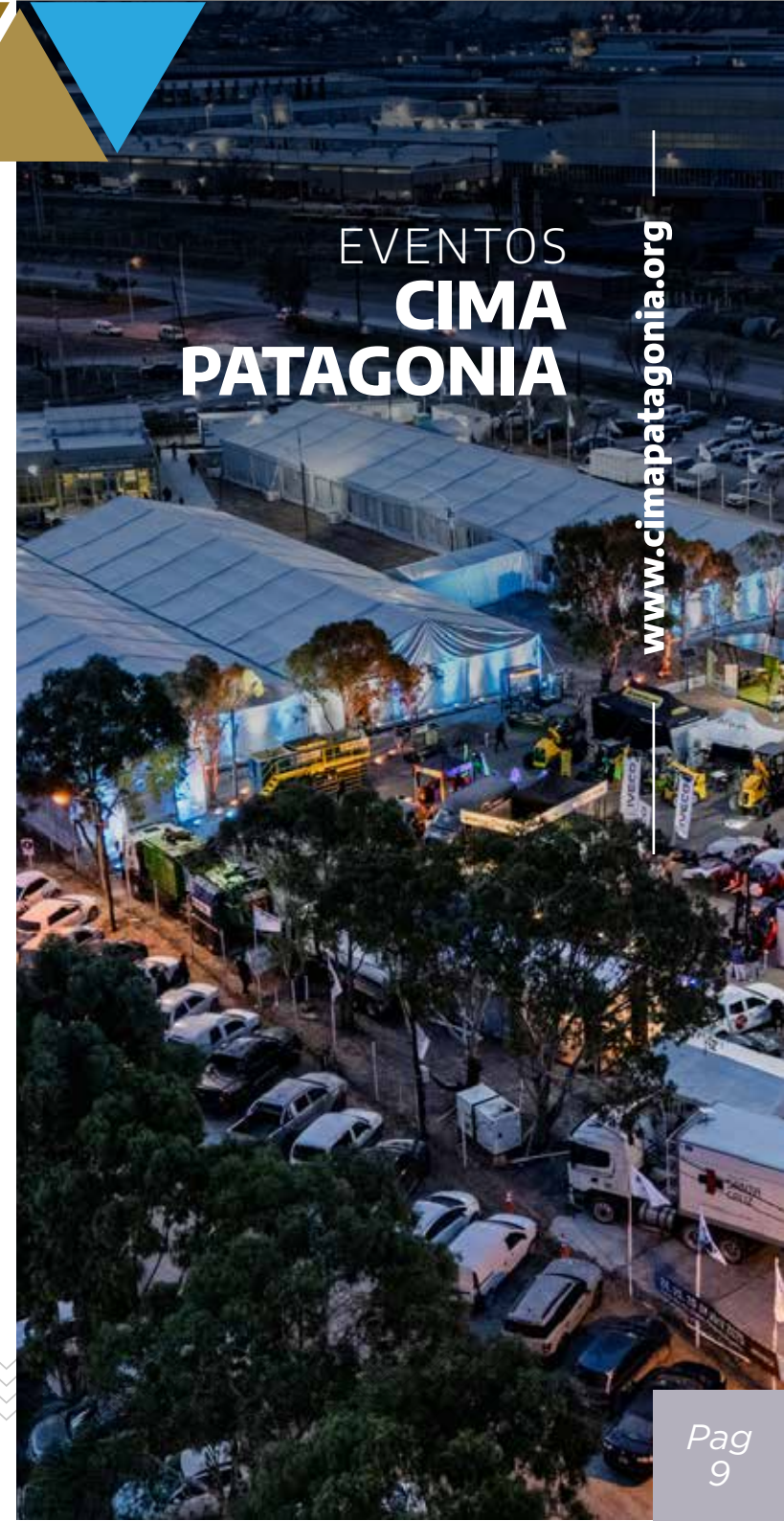
EVENPa - The Most Important Multisector Business Event in Patagonia
